

Name of Activity: Evidence-Inference-Action Activity

Preparation Time: 15 minutes

Activity Time: 15 - 20 minutes

Preparation:

1. Print the “*Evidence-Inference-Action*” worksheet and copy for each participant.
2. Download and insert the Power Point slides on Evidence-Inference-Action into appropriate section of the training.

Activity Instructions:

1. Begin the activity by providing a brief overview of the Evidence-Inference-Action Model using the Power Point slides as a guide.
2. Divide the participants into small groups of 4 or 5. For 15 minutes, ask the groups to review the ‘evidence’ provided on the “*Evidence-Inference-Action*” worksheet and discuss the possible inferences and actions.
3. In the remaining 5-10 minutes, debrief as a large group. Discuss the possible inferences and actions that might be made based on the evidence (i.e. a possible inference may be that the data are not quality data, and the corresponding action(s) would relate to improving the quality of the data).

Activity Variations:

- If training a small group of participants (i.e. less than 10), this activity may be completed as a large group.
