Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Agencies

Supports timely agency to agency transitions and provides data for analysis of children's services and child outcomes across programs.





Early Childhood Integrated Data Systems (ECIDS) -Provides data for analysis of services and impacts based on program participation.

Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS) - Supports understanding whether children are participating in high quality early childhood programs and addresses program professional development needs.

Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) - Increases efficiencies in referral process, supports analysis of data across programs, and enhances agency collaboration.
