Positive Outcome

- Increased number of screenings— no longer at bottom of ranking, now in middle. Nemours Pediatric Satellite Clinics screen as part of their own EMR and electronic referrals made to CDW.
- Areas Needing Improvement
 - Has been no integrated database between PEDS and ASQ –not tracking screenings by child across screenings to avoid duplication.
 - After PEDS and ASQ screenings needs comprehensive tracking system that referral made to CDW. Many PCPs have EMR that doesn't link directly to CDW.
