

COMING SOON Update to the Part C Eligibility Policies Table and Paper

What is the Part C Eligibility Policies Table and Paper?

This resource will summarize current issues and trends in state policies on eligibility for Part C services. Each state's eligibility policy is included, along with links to supporting state resources when available (e.g. list of diagnosed conditions; specific or unique policies for eligibility, etc.). Data on whether the state reports serving at-risk populations is also included.

What's new in the update?

State eligibility policies and procedures evolve over time to meet the unique and changing needs in states. In addition to updating research and regulatory alignment, key new areas of focus include how states are addressing special populations in their eligibility policies, including:

- Prematurity and/or low birth weight;
- Substance exposure (NAS, opiates, etc.);
- Child maltreatment; and
- Zika
