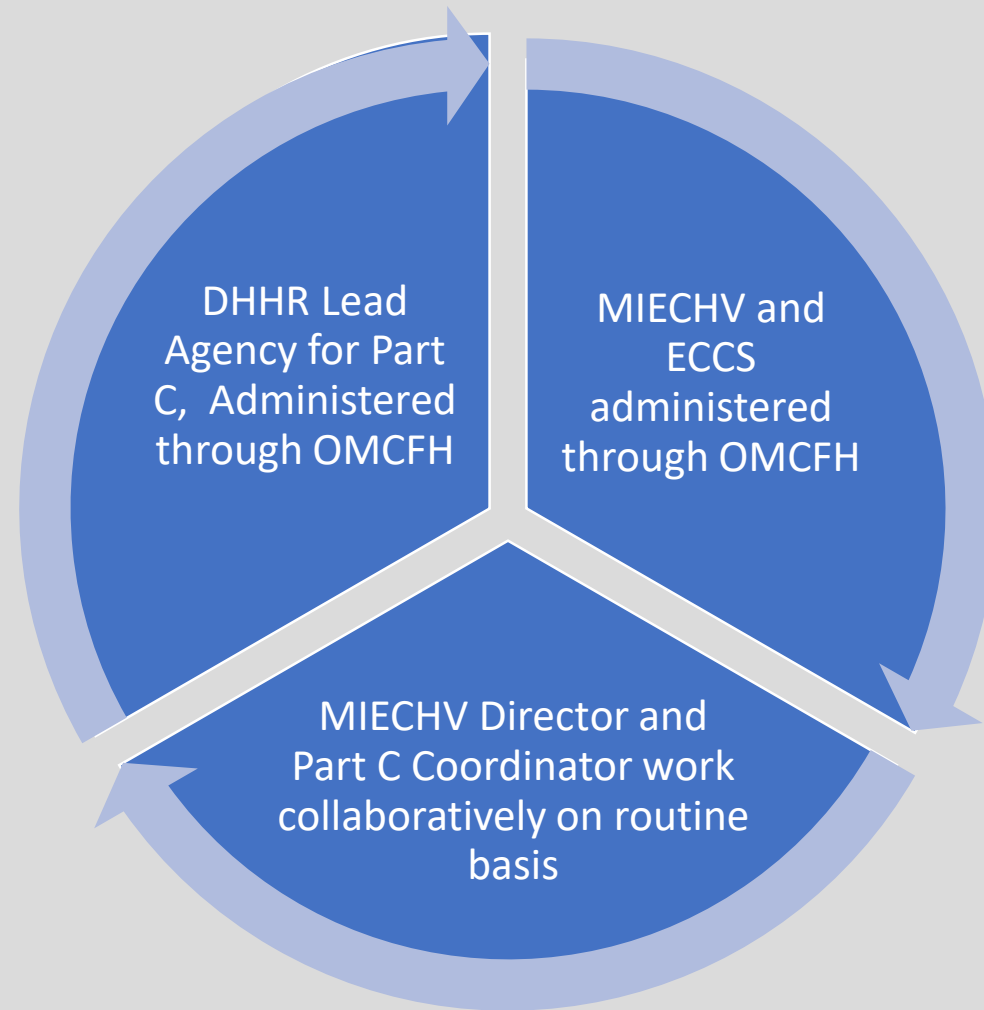

Impact on Programs

Decreased family engagement

Increased need for training on meeting the needs of families

Increased need for resources for families served

Increased bias on working with families

Increased nontraditional family settings

Other Collaboration at the State Level

- Number of referrals
- Number of children jointly served with HV and Part C
- Strength based and embedding the Strengthening Families framework and Protective Factors into daily work
- Understanding the impact of substance abuse on the families and not approaching families in a way that will turn a family off from services
- Realizing the critical role the early childhood provider can have at that time in a family's life

Serving Families

- Do you serve families who have infants and toddlers receiving both HV and Part C?

Barriers

- Have there been barriers that make it difficult to serve infants and toddlers who are receiving both services?

What We Learned from the Programs

Referrals are being made, follow up is received. Sometimes HV is invited to the meetings.

In some areas families may not want multiple people in their homes. In other areas, Part C and HV are jointly serving families.

Other collaborations locally include joint presentations, training and recruitment of providers.
