

Educational Environments, 2013-2014 Sample LEA

Indicator 6 of the State Performance Plan (SPP) reports the percent of children ages 3-5 (A) attending a Regular Early Childhood Program (RECP) and receiving the majority of special education and related service in the regular early childhood program, and (B) attending a special education class, separate school or residential facility (Educational Environments). States are required to set performance targets. North Carolina targets: (A) 51.5% and (B) 20.5%.

The first chart compares state and LEA performance to the target. The second chart compares educational environments of 3, 4 and 5 yr olds in prekindergarten to five year olds in kindergarten.




